Notes on Gift Aid

Gift Aid is only applicable to UK taxpayers.

You must notify the charities you support if you:

- want to cancel your declaration,
- change your name or home address
- no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains.

If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue & Customs to adjust your tax code.

Gift Aid declarations must be completed individually. Joint forms for couples are invalid.

If you are unsure whether your giving qualifies for Gift Aid tax relief, please contact your local tax office for advice and ask for leaflet IR65.
